

GlobalStar Launch On Boeing Delta II Scheduled For February 14

A Boeing Delta II stands ready at Cape Canaveral Air Station (CCAS), Fla. to carry the first four Globalstar satellites into orbit for Space Systems/Loral. The launch window on Feb. 14 opens at 8:22 a.m. EST and closes at 9:47 a.m.

Accredited media wishing to view the launch from the viewing site should meet at Pass and ID at 7 a.m. EST, Feb. 14.

Live Satellite Broadcast Feed

Boeing and Globalstar will provide a live satellite broadcast feed of the launch starting at approximately 8 a.m. Satellite coordinates are: Telstar 5, Transponder 17, C-Band.
