Known as the world's first jumbo jet, the 747 still is the world's largest commercial jetliner. The 747 is the best-selling twin-aisle jetliner in the industry, with nearly 1,200 delivered. Over the years, Boeing has built 15 different 747 models. The 747-400, currently the only model in production, entered commercial service in 1989 and has sold more than any other 747 version.
