New England Financial will produce 15 to 20 programs annually at its headquarters in Boston.

The programs will be transmitted to DigitalXpress via fiber optic lines to the DigitalXpress operations center in St. Paul, Minn., where they will be uplinked and broadcast to WaveNET sites.

"With a widely dispersed field staff, it's critical that New England Financial invest in a cost-effective technology that sends simultaneous, unified messages to field associates from our home office," said Scott Nussey, WaveNET manager.
