"Boeing has been a market leader in the Middle East for approximately 53 years," said Belyamani. "Our commitment to Dubai 2000 reflects our intention of maintaining that leadership position, and in creating superior value for our Middle East customers by offering the most complete line of products and services."

Belyamani emphasized that Boeing continues to be the market leader in the commercial airplane industry, noting that the company will deliver 620 commercial airplanes in 1999.

"This year Boeing will deliver 68-percent of the industry's new airplanes to airlines throughout the world. Industry leadership is proven through performance, and we will again lead the way in 1999, " he said.

With 1998 revenues approaching \$57 billion - Boeing is the world's number one aerospace company, and is the United States' top exporter, with nearly half of its revenue coming from international sales. More than 70 percent of Boeing business comes from commercial customers; about 30 percent is derived from U.S. government business. Boeing employs about 200,000 people worldwide.
