In addition, CIT has taken options for five additional 757-300s. The value of the new airplanes on firm order is estimated at more than \$1.3 billion at list prices.

CIT is the first lessor to offer the newest member of the Boeing 757 family, which has the lowest seat-mile costs of any single-aisle jetliner, making it an extremely cost-effective airplane for airlines to operate.

The 737-700 seats between 126 and 149 passengers and can fly more than 3,200 nautical miles. The Next-Generation 737 family features one of the highest dispatch reliability rates in the industry and is the best-selling new commercial airplane in history, with more than 1,700 ordered since the program was launched in November 1993.
