Boeing [NYSE:BA] announced today that it has completed the acquisition of Conquest, Inc., a premier provider of enterprise architecture, systems engineering, and software technology solutions to the intelligence community. Terms were not disclosed.

The unit becomes Boeing Advanced Information Systems -- Maryland Operations, a department of Boeing Space and Intelligence Systems, or S&IS, Boeing's center for all intelligence programs. Headquartered in Annapolis Junction, Md., the new unit adds approximately 200 employees to the Boeing roster and a contract backlog valued at \$250 million over the next three years.

"Conquest's excellent history of support to the intelligence community and Boeing's experience in large-scale systems integration will provide a greater offering to future needs within that customer community."
