The Boeing Company [NYSE: BA] today announced that James (Jim) W. Coon has been named director of Legislative Affairs, Commercial Airplanes, for Boeing Washington, D.C. Operations. Coon, 43, joins Boeing from the Air Transport Association (ATA) in Washington, D.C., where he worked as director of Government Affairs. Effective this week, he reports to Mike Matton, vice president of Legislative Affairs for Washington, D.C. Operations.

Prior to his service with Duncan, he was a legislative assistant for Rep. Robert Smith (R-OR).

Coon earned a bachelor's degree from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in 1982. He also served as an infantry officer in the U.S. Army Reserve from 1990 through 2001.
