

## **Eye-Catching Winglets, New Colors Distinguish Luxair's First Boeing 737-700**

Luxair's first Boeing Next-Generation 737-700, sporting the airline's new livery and a pair of elegant blended winglets on its wingtips, began operations this month. Luxair, the national airline of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, is using the new airplane on scheduled flights within Europe and on chartered holiday flights to sunshine destinations. The blended winglets reduce takeoff noise at airports, reduce fuel costs and increase the distance the 737-700 can fly.
