The program separately will select providers of items including lavatories, galleys, passenger seats, water system and escape slides. Those suppliers are to be chosen by year's end.

"Our team's creativity, innovation and hard work allowed us to be selected as the 7E7 main cabin partner," said Elizabeth Lund, the Interiors Responsibility Center's director. "This is a milestone on our journey to becoming the world's premier choice for aircraft interiors."

The 7E7 is an all-new family of mid-sized airplanes that will provide exceptional fuel efficiencies for airlines and superior comfort for passengers. It is to enter service in 2008.
