The Boeing 367-80 airplane, commonly known as the "Dash 80," was publicly unveiled on May 14, 1954. The prototype of the Boeing 707 -- the world's first commercially successful jet-powered passenger plane -- the Dash 80 helped forever change commercial aviation.
