Boeing Statement: Boeing donates \$1 million for tsunami relief

The Boeing Company has committed \$1 million to support humanitarian efforts of three nonprofit agencies assisting tsunami victims in Southeast Asia. Boeing will work with the agencies -- CARE USA, Mercy Corps, and the American Red Cross -- to determine the best allocation of resources.
