Deal also held various positions within Boeing, including leading key initiatives for the 717 program. He also served as Japan Airlines program manager on the MD-11 program.

Since February 2001, Laird has served as vice president of China Sales for Commercial Airplanes. Previously, Laird was deputy to the vice president and business director for Commercial Sales. Prior to this assignment he supported Dickenson in a similar capacity for the Asia Pacific region.
