

## **Boeing Appoints Engineering and Technology Leader in India**

### **Naveed Hussain Named as Vice President, Engineering and Technology**

**New Delhi, Jan. 24, 2008**-- The Boeing Company [NYSE:BA] announced today that Naveed Hussain will serve in India as its Vice President of Engineering and Technology.

Additionally, he has been actively involved in leading strategic technology planning, R&D and product development processes. Hussain holds a Ph.D. from Stanford University in Mechanical Engineering and an M.B.A. from The Wharton School of Business, University of Pennsylvania.
