RAS AL KHAIMAH, United Arab Emirates, Feb. 25, 2008-- Boeing [NYSE: BA] and RAK Airways today held a signing ceremony for the procurement of four [737-800s](#) with purchase rights for two additional 737s. The deal is valued at approximately \$300 million at list prices.

Today's signing ceremony, held at the Al Hamra Fort Hotel, was hosted by RAK Airways' Chairman H.H. Sheikh Omar Bin Saqr Al Qasimi and Marty Bentrott, vice president of Sales for the Middle East and Africa, Boeing Commercial Airplanes.

"RAK Airways believes in providing premium service to its customers, in line with our strategy to enhance customer services by adding new destinations, increased frequency and new-generation aircraft.
