Roman to Lead Boeing State and Local Government Operations

WASHINGTON, Nov. 18, 2009 -- The Boeing Company [NYSE: BA] has named George C. Roman vice president, State and Local Government Operations. The functions of State and Local Government Operations and Global Corporate Citizenship for both Boeing Commercial Airplanes and Integrated Defense Systems (IDS) will now report to Roman. He joined the company in St. Louis in 1980 and held increasingly responsible assignments across the business. In 1997, Roman became vice president for International Operations, and in 2001, he was named vice president and general manager of Business Development for Boeing Military Aircraft and Missile Systems.

Roman holds bachelor's and master's degrees in business administration from Pennsylvania State University.
