

Boeing Names Laura J. Peterson Vice President for NW State & Local Government Operations

Appointment rounds out Boeing's local government and philanthropic team

SEATTLE, Aug. 3 /PRNewswire-FirstCall/ -- Boeing (NYSE: BA) has named Laura J. Peterson vice president for State & Local Government Operations in the Northwest region.

She will lead the team responsible for Boeing's political and government activities in the region, which includes Washington and Oregon.

Peterson most recently served as vice president for Business Development and Global Strategy, Boeing Commercial Airplanes. In her new position she will report to Jim Albaugh, Boeing Commercial Airplanes president and chief executive officer; and to George Roman, Boeing vice president for State & Local Government Operations in the United States.

Ensuring long-term prosperity for state and U.S. aerospace sectors, amid competitive pressures and a recovering economy requires strong relationships and stable leadership.

She succeeds Fred Kiga, who left the company earlier this year.
