

Boeing Delivers 400th Airplane to GECAS

- Xiamen Airlines to operate the milestone airplane

- GECAS placed first Boeing airplane order in 1995

SEATTLE, July 21, 2011 /[PRNewswire](#)/ -- Boeing (NYSE: BA) reached a major milestone with GE Capital Aviation Services (GECAS) yesterday by delivering the leasing company's 400th airplane, a Next-Generation 737-800. GECAS leasing customer Xiamen Airlines will operate the milestone airplane.
