Since the launch of the 777 CSP in 2003, 47 percent of all new 777 operators have opted to take part. To date, 18 airlines are under contract for a total of 177 aircraft supported. In 2013, in addition to signing up Garuda Indonesia for ten aircraft, the 777 CSP also renewed existing contracts with TAAG Angola Airlines, Kenya Airways and Ethiopian Airlines.
