

Boeing Recognized for Successful Small Business Mentorship

Department of Defense award salutes company's work with small, disadvantaged businesses

HUNTSVILLE, Ala., March 16, 2015— Boeing [NYSE: BA] and Huntsville, Ala.-based Victory Solutions Inc. are among 14 pair of contractor-supplier partners selected by the U.S. Department of Defense for the prestigious Nunn-Perry Award. The honor, named for former U.S. Sen.
