With the fuselage stretched 20 feet (6 meters) over the 787-8, the 787-9 can fly more passengers and more cargo farther yet with the same exceptional environmental efficiency – 20 percent less fuel use and emissions than the airplanes they replace.

Through May 2015, 30 customers from around the world have ordered 509 787-9s, 46 percent of all 787 orders.
