

Boeing, Somon Air Announce Order for Two Next-Generation 737-900ERs

SEATTLE, March 4 [/PRNewswire-FirstCall/](#) -- Boeing (NYSE: BA) and Dushanbe, Tajikistan-based Somon Air today announced an order for two Next-Generation 737-900ERs (Extended Range). The order is valued at \$163 million at list prices.

The order represents Somon Air's first direct purchase of airplanes from Boeing.
