

Boeing Donates \$250,000 to Support Relief Efforts in Houston and New Mexico

ARLINGTON, Va., July 22, 2024 – Boeing [NYSE: BA] is committing \$250,000 from the Boeing Charitable Trust to assist with recovery and relief efforts in Houston following Hurricane Beryl and in New Mexico in the wake of devastating wildfires.

Funds will support the following organizations:

- **\$75,000 to [Combined Arms](#)** to provide food assistance to the 19,000+ veterans in the Harris County region;
- **\$75,000 to [Houston Food Bank](#)** to provide food and water assistance to communities in Harris County and other affected regions;
- **\$50,000 to [Precinct2gether](#)** for cooling centers, repairs and other assistance in Harris County;
- **\$50,000 to [Community Foundation of Southern New Mexico](#)** to support the immediate and long-term recovery needs for the people, animals and places affected by the wildfires in Southern New Mexico.
