

Boeing Donates \$200,000 to Support Flooding Recovery Efforts in Texas

ARLINGTON, Va., July 9-- Boeing (NYSE: BA) is donating \$200,000 from the Boeing Charitable Trust to assist with recovery and relief efforts in the aftermath of devastating flooding in central Texas.

Funding will support the following organizations:

- **\$100,000 to [Salvation Army San Antonio Area Command](#)** to support emergency shelters and provide food, emotional support and health services to those impacted
- **\$100,000 to [Kerr County Flood Relief Fund](#)** to support trusted organizations in Kerrville providing rescue, relief and recovery efforts as well as flood assistance

“We extend our heartfelt condolences to those who are grappling with unimaginable loss and uncertainty in the aftermath of the flooding,” said Jeff Shockey, executive vice president of Boeing Government Operations, Global Public Policy, and Corporate Strategy. “With Boeing teammates in the region personally feeling the impacts of this tragedy, we deeply appreciate the work of our local partners who are supporting a pathway to recovery.”
